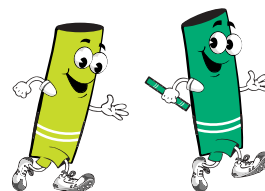


COUNTRY FINANCIAL[®] KIDS RELAYS



June 1, 2019 • Parents' Information–Event Day

Thank you for participating in the 45th annual COUNTRY Financial Kids Relays! We know your time is precious, and we thank you for making the time commitment for your child(ren) to participate. Below is important information about the event.

Time Commitment—Here is an approximate time frame, which takes into consideration the time your child is dropped off at the Runner Drop-Off until the time they will be ready to be picked up at the Runner Pick-Up.

2nd Grade	8:15 a.m. – 10:15 a.m.
1st Grade	9:45 a.m. – 11:45 a.m.
3rd Grade	11:30 a.m. – 1:30 p.m.
4th Grade	1:00 p.m. – 2:30 p.m.
5th Grade & Mayor's Mile	2:15 p.m. – 4:15 p.m.

Runner Drop-Off—Runners are to report to the Runner Drop-Off area located east of the stadium and next to the tennis courts (see map on back). This is a secure, fenced area where runners will be escorted by approved volunteers from the drop-off entrance to their school meeting spot. Each school will have a volunteer waiting with the runners by the associated school sign until it is time to parade onto the track.

Parade Schedule—Each grade level parades by school into the stadium from the Runner Drop-Off area on the approximate schedule:

2nd Grade	8:30 a.m.
1st Grade	10:00 a.m.
3rd Grade	11:45 a.m.
4th Grade	1:15 p.m.
5th Grade & Mayor's Mile	2:30 p.m.

Awards—Runners will be taken to the awards station on the field after their race. Once they have received their award, runners will go back to their respective school tent.

Runner Pick-Up—For the safety of the participants, all runners will be available for pick-up at the end of their grade level, only in the Runner Pick-Up Area. We appreciate your patience as we try to get your child to you quickly and safely!

1. Exit the stadium and head up the Soap Box Derby track.
2. As you approach the Runner Pick-Up Area, the left side is for schools starting with the letters A-K, and the right side is for schools starting with the letters L-Y.
3. Please send one person to pick up your child. This should be an adult the school is familiar with. Each school is responsible for pairing the correct child with the correct adult, so please make this easy on them.

We have approximately 650 runners we are trying to pair up with a parent as quickly as possible. Following the steps above will ensure our ability to do this!

Reminders

Clothing and Shoes—The relays take place rain or shine, so dress for the weather! Running spikes or shoes designed to accommodate spikes are **not allowed**.

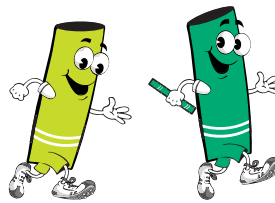
Food and Drink—Concessions are available throughout the event for spectators. Participants are only allowed to have clear water on the field, so be sure to feed your child before arriving at the stadium. Some schools hand out snacks to the runners, but the runners will have to wait until they have exited the field before eating the snacks. May Trucking provides all runners with water while they are on the field.

Parking—Parking around Bush's Pasture Park is limited. Plan ahead and factor walk time into your arrival.

Practices—Willamette University's track is not available for practicing. Please do not call to ask, and do not drop in to practice. Your athletes will perform to their best ability, even if they practice elsewhere!

Stadium Rules—Tobacco, smoking, and e-vaping are not allowed inside the park nor inside the stadium. Only certified service animals are allowed inside the stadium.
